## LESSON ATTENDANCE AND MAKE-UP POLICY

Thank you for keeping missed lessons to a minimum this year. For those unavoidable times when a lesson must be canceled, the following guidelines apply:

1. To be eligible for a make-up lesson, please contact your teacher at home **at least 24 hours ahead of the scheduled lesson.**
2. **A maximum of two individual make-up lessons per year is allowed** (one per semester). If a scheduled make-up lesson is missed without notice, it will be forfeited. Teachers may occasionally offer extra time toward make-ups at their discretion as their schedule allows; however this should be considered a bonus, not a guarantee. **No monetary credit is given for missed lessons.**
3. If school is canceled in Newtown or Woodbury, this **usually** means that lessons are canceled. However, if the weather clears, your teacher will call to see if you can attend your lesson.
4. Lessons missed due to teacher cancellation are guaranteed to be made up.

## GUIDELINES ON STARTING AND STOPPING LESSONS

**Starting lessons:** Students may start lessons at any time of the year; the first month or semester will be pro-rated.

**Stopping lessons:** If a student decides to stop taking lessons, we ask that he or she finish out the current semester (end of February and end of June). **We require at least 30 days notice by telephone or email to the director of intent to stop lessons. If less than 30 days' notice has been received, you will be billed for any scheduled lessons within that time period.**

Please be sure that your payments are up to date when you give notice of your intent to stop lessons.
